DSKL graduates celebrated their International Abitur and O-Level graduation together with parents, teachers and friends on Saturday, 26 May 2018 at The Ritz-Carlton Hotel.

Among the guests were the Austrian ambassador, HE Dr. Michael Postl and the German ambassador, HE Nikolaus Graf Lambsdorff, who emphasised in his welcoming speech the immense value of a school graduation certificate for young people in a global environment.

Dr. Mayer, the school's principal, and class teachers, Mr Frese and Mr Lübke, conveyed

their best wishes to the candidates. A potpourri of musical presentations entertained the audience right up to the ceremonial award of graduation certificates.

The 2017/2018 high school graduates, with 17 students, is one of the largest graduation classes in the past few years, achieved an outstanding overall average grade of 2.0, an excellent result in national comparison. Sebastian Bauer attained the second best result ever awarded for the International Abitur at DSKL. Nadine Schärmann was conferred awards of the German Mathematics Association and the

German Physics Association. The prestigious Scheffel Prize of the Literary Association Karlsruhe went to Niklas Huth. Sebastian Bauer and Niklas Huth received the award of the Foundation Nature, Humans, Culture for their joint long-term project on "Sustainable Coffee Cultivation".

Three O-Level graduates are planning to continue their educational career at DSKL right up to the Abitur.
